The staff has done a very good job keeping the number of rules to a minimum, and stating the rules simply and as positive behavior expectations. Based on the photos you sent, the signage looks great. It also sounds as though the corrections to policy that were suggested are being made. I look forward to seeing the signs and the new/amended policies during our site visit in October.

I'm happy to hear that Sgt. Hunt and the staff have implemented the coupon-based PBMS reinforcement system starting on a small scale, which we discussed in April, and which is now being expanded to another unit. I expect this new reinforcement system will likely be fully implemented through the facility when we return this fall. It seems as though the JDC is working hard to support the recommendations I made.

I appreciate the update, and I look forward to seeing everyone again in October.
